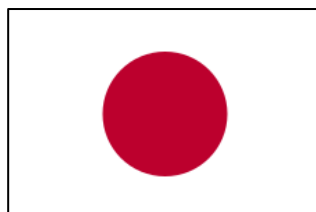

In a rural Spanish town, Bernarda, the matriarch of the old and distinguished Alba family, exercises her power after the death of her husband. Strict and authoritarian, Bernarda forces her five unmarried daughters to observe an eight-year period of mourning, confining them to the family manor. The young women, in the prime of their lives, are increasingly repressed and frustrated by their isolation. Into this stifling atmosphere, a handsome young man named Pepe arrives as the fiancé of the eldest daughter, Justyna, stirring up trouble in this female-dominated household.

Based on one of Federico GARCÍA LORCA's three great tragedies, along with Blood Wedding and Yerma, this work depicts the tragic lives of women confined to a house bound by rigid traditions.
